**Primary Election August 2, 2022**

Last Day to **Register** to Vote is **July 6, 2022**

To **register** online go to:

<https://www.sos.mo.gov/elections/goVoteMissouri/register> this link gives several ways you can register. (You must be 17 ½ to register to vote)

Do you have any events coming up that you could set up a **Register to Vote table**?

Work with the VFW and set up a Register to Vote table next to a USPS Mailbox at your local Fair or Parade and provide registration cards for your County and Postage. Have Computers, tablets or QR Codes so they can do it on their cell phone, you may want to offer assistance. Make sure it is a Politically Neutral table but have the VFW Priority Goals available. We support Bills not political parties or persons. This activity will complete questions #3 & #4 on the year-end report.
