Every VFW District in the Department of Missouri is eligible to obtain the “**District All-State Achievement Award**” for 2024-2025. The criteria is listed below. Keep this with you so you can check off each item that you have achieved as an Auxiliary. Your District needs to obtain **180** points out of **200** to obtain the District All-State Achievement Award.

## Criteria for obtaining the “All-State Achievement Award.”

### 1. Growth in District Membership:

Membership standings by June 1, 2025, based on June 30, 2024, final membership standings.
