If you find yourself wondering what to do for the children, please go into MALTA under resources (Americanism) and look for FLAG EDUCATION FOR KIDS!!


This gives you a handout to print off and take to a school. Hand out flags while you are there and show them the proper way to salute the flag.

EDUCATION

A project you can do during this SLOW time is to teach and demonstrate the proper way to dispose of flags.

Flag Disposal: This should only be done with adult supervision! - The Flag should be folded in its customary manner. - It is important that the fire be fairly large and of sufficient intensity to ensure complete burning of the Flag. - Place the Flag on the fire. - The individual(s) can come to attention, salute the Flag, recite the Pledge of Allegiance and have a brief period of silent reflection. - After the Flag is completely consumed, the fire should then be safely extinguished and the ashes buried. - Please make sure you are conforming to local/state fire codes or ordinances.

It's never to early to plan for Patriotic Days with Memorial Day being the next one to come. Think of an event that the Post and Auxiliary members can do together to educate your community. Remember that the Auxiliary does not exist without our Post. Remember we are here for our Veterans. - If you have a recurring project that is multiple times a month, you may accumulate those hours and report them one time at the end of the month. In your description, please include the dates that your Auxiliary or member participated in.

• Be creative and descriptive when reporting the project. Did something fun and unexpected happen? Report it so you will catch my eye!

2024 Legislative Priority Goals

Missouri Association of Military Organizations (MAVO)

Legislative Priorities for the upcoming 2024-2025 Legislative Year

- Fully fund the Missouri Veterans Commission (MVC)
- Yearly MVC must go back to general revenue to support the VSOs, state cemeteries and state veterans homes. \$50 million last year
- Enhance real and personal property tax exemptions for 100% disabled veterans. Currently there is a tax exemption for veterans that are 100% disabled **and** are former prisoners of war. This narrow exemption provides assistance to very few Missouri veterans, change **and** to **or.** This would be a constitutional change.
- Support legislation that protects veterans from predatory actors who seek to profit from benefits that have been earned by those who serve our nation (Claim Sharks). MVC VSOs and their grant partners receive no payment taken from the veterans benefits.

Prefiling of bills took place in December. House and Senate bills will obtain their assigned number; that information will be forthcoming.

119th United States Congress

Auxiliary membership chairman should be including instructions to their members when sending dues notice letters on how they can easily pay their dues on MALTA. Explain to them the benefits of paying on MALTA. No more paying postage to mail checks via snail mail or waiting for checks to clear you bank account. There is no added fee to pay your dues via MALTA and it is quick and easy. When members pay their own dues via MALTA your auxiliary will receive an ACH into your Auxiliary bank account from National for your portion of the dues.

The VFW Auxiliary is pleased to present this National Scholarship to assist VFW Auxiliary members and their immediate family who wish to further their education by pursuing a college degree or a career direction at a vocational/technical school. One (1) scholarship will be awarded each year to a selected candidate in each of the four (4) VFW Auxiliary Conferences. The \$1,250 scholarship shall be used in the academic year following completion of the contest. The scholarship will be paid directly to the American college/university or vocational/technical school of the awardee's choice.

Eligibility: VFW Auxiliary member for at least one full year by the application submission deadline of February 15. The spouse, son and/or daughter of a VFW Auxiliary member that has been a member at least one full year by the application submission deadline of February 15. Applicants must be 21 years of age or older by the application submission deadline of February 15. Previous National Continuing Education Scholarship winners are not eligible.

Speak with your local schools, churches, scout troops and clubs and provide them with contest information.



The Illustrating America Art Contest is open to any student in grades K-8 who is enrolled in public, private, or parochial school or home study program in the United States, its territories and possessions, or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in overseas schools. Students must be a U.S. citizen or lawful U.S. permanent resident. Foreign exchange students and students age 15 or older are ineligible.

- Entries will be judged on patriotic themes and technique
- Contest will consist of three grade divisions: K-2, 3-5, and 6-8
- Entries are due to Auxiliaries by March 31, 2025
- First place winner from each grade division due to Department by April 15, 2025

There has been a change made to the rules form – It is now **Required** that the student's name, age and grade level be written on the back of every art entry. The updated entry form and contest rules are included in these General Orders and can also be found at vfwauxmo.org, under Youth Activities.

As we involve our youth in "Helping Veterans by Bridging the Gap With Teamwork", let us never forget that "From Our Roots to Our Branches, Extending Service to Our Veterans" is the reason we exist.

Illustrating America Art Contest 2024-2025

VFW Auxiliary National is pleased to present this National art contest to introduce, encourage and recognize young artists with patriotism through art. Entries will be judged on patriotic theme and technique.

Contest Eligibility

- Student does not have to be related to a VFW or VFW Auxiliary member to participate
- Students in grades K-8 by March 31 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private, parochial or home school program in the United States, its territories and possessions, or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in overseas schools.
- Although U.S. citizenship is not required, students must be lawful U.S. permanent residents or have applied for permanent resident (the application for which has not been denied) and intends to become a U.S. citizen.
- Foreign exchange students, students aged 15 or older are not eligible.
- Previous winners of VFW Auxiliary National Illustrating America Art Contests are **not** eligible for the same grade division of which they are a previous national winner. However, the students may enter the subsequent grade division.

Contest Rules

- Entry must be completed during the current school year.
- Entry must be two dimensional.
- Entry must be on canvas or paper.
- Canvas entries must be submitted on a stretcher frame or canvas board.
- Paper entries must be reinforced with heavy paper.
- Do not frame art with wood, metal, plastic or glass.
- Mats may be used, including mounted and floating mats.
- Entries may **not** be smaller than 8"x10" and **not** larger than 18"x24" **including** mat.
- Acrylic, chalk, crayon, ink, marker, pastel, pen, pencil, tempera, watercolor, glitter or other media may be used.
- If the American Flag is used, it does **not** need conform to the Federal Flag Code in relation to colors, numbers of stars and stripes and other pertinent rules of the code.
- Coloring sheets, digital art and photography are not accepted.
- Completed typed or printed legible entry form including parent and/or guardian signatures.
- Students name, age and grade level must be printed on back of art entry.

VFW Auxiliary judging dates and deadlines:

- March 31: Student entries must be submitted to a participating sponsoring VFW Auxiliary for judging.
- **April 15**: First place winner from each grade division from participating sponsoring VFW Auxiliary or **optional** VFW Auxiliary District advances to the VFW Auxiliary Department (state) for judging.
- May 5: First place winner from grade division from each Department (state) due to VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters for judging.
- **July/August:** All students will be notified of entry status via email provided on entry form. First through third place winning entries in each grade division will be announced on VFW Auxiliary National social media pages and may be shown at the VFW Auxiliary National Convention.
- **September:** All art entries received at VFW Auxiliary National will be returned to students to the address provided on the entry form.
