Every VFW Auxiliary District in the Department of Missouri is eligible to obtain the “**District All-State Achievement Award**” for 2026-2027. The criteria are listed below. Keep this with you so you can check off each item that you have achieved as a District. **Documentation will be Required.** Your District needs to obtain **250** points out of **270** to obtain the District All-State Achievement Award.

Criteria for obtaining the “All-State Achievement Award.”

1. Growth in District Membership:

Membership standings by June 1, 2027, based on June 30, 2026, final membership standings.

2. President Leadership:

The District President will make sure the following are completed.

All Auxiliaries in your District entered their Installation Reports in MALTA or emailed a copy to the Department Secretary by June 20, 2026	10	
All Auxiliaries must submit the list of Department Delegates/Alternates and Fees to the Department Treasurer by May 30, 2026	10	
District will file their 990s with the IRS by November 15, 2026 . The District (Treasurer will send a copy of the submission, listing the District number, to the Department Treasurer.)	10	
The District Offices of President and Treasurer are bonded for 1.25% of the District Funds by July 30, 2026	10	
All the Auxiliaries in your District were bonded by July 30, 2026	10	
The Audits of the District were sent on time each quarter to the Department Treasurer.	40	
The District President presided over each District Meeting. (10 pts for each meeting with a maximum of 40 pts) (The District Secretary sends the District Roll Call to the District All-State Chairman.)	40	
The District President attended one of the Department School of Instructions.	10	
The District President held one District School of Instructions before August 30, 2026 . (Documentation is Required such as Agenda, signup sheet, meeting notice, etc.)	10
